Background

Approximately 270 acres within the IM subdivision is your public land managed by the IMRPD. The most popular area is called Indian Mountain (IM) Park where the old ski area and comfort station is located. We also have another 86 acres three miles east along Albino Road. The IMRPD is governed by its 1975 Service Plan and today supports a number of facilities and services: hiking trails, comfort station, playground, pond, picnic pavilion, parklands and open space, wildlife corridors, sledding hill, pasture golf course, frisbee golf course, RV storage lot, RV dump station, horseshoe pits, archery range, an old recreation hall, and other basic amenities.
